Parent/Students

Antivirus Protection

- Make sure personal devices are up to date on antivirus protection

Secure Internet Connections

- Make sure to log into your home router, not a shared network
- Strengthen your password for your home router
- Avoid accessing any confidential or sensitive information from a public WiFi network

Phishing Emails

- Be aware of phishing emails designed to entice you to click on the latest and greatest offer related to coronavirus protections; the intent is to get you to unsuspectingly download malware onto your device

Bluetooth

- Avoid using Bluetooth in a public place

Virtual Meeting Safety

- Administration is working with classroom teachers and staff to maintain and enhance safe virtual meeting practices (Zoom, Google Meet, etc.) by enabling the waiting room and password features; this information will be conveyed to students/parents directly by the classroom teacher
