A.D. HENDERSON UNIVERSITY SCHOOL & FAU HIGH SCHOOL DRESS CODE

DRESS CODE POLICY

Kindergarten – 5th Grade

Personal Appearance and Accessories

- Belts: Recommended for students in 3rd – 5th grades, with pants, shorts, and skorts that have belt loops.
- Accessories: All accessories must be appropriate for school, not pose a threat to health / safety, and must not be distracting. This includes jewelry, socks, and other wearables.
 - Head attire, including kerchiefs, caps, hats, bandanas, scarves, and similar items are not permitted, except for religious reasons.
 - Hair presentation, including spray painting hair, dying hair to an unnatural hair color, and/or distracting style, is not permitted.
 - Sunglasses may not be worn indoors unless a doctor's note is on file with the school nurse.
- Backpacks: Backpacks are permitted at every grade level and must be neat and organized at all times.

Shirts

- Type: Students must wear knit polo shirts with the A.D. Henderson University School logo offered by *Wizard Creations*.
- Color: Solid navy blue, solid white, or solid red are acceptable colors. (Striped shirts may no longer be worn)
- Presentation: Shirts must be tucked in at all times. No clothing item may be faded, frayed, or have holes.

Bottoms

- Type: Students must wear traditional (chino-style flat front) uniform pants, shorts, or appropriate length skorts.
- Color: Solid khaki or solid navy blue are acceptable colors.
- Presentation: Pants must be appropriately sized and securely fastened at the waist. No clothing item may be faded, frayed or have holes.
- Type prohibited: Shorts and skorts must not be rolled down at the waist and/or rolled up at the hem line, and must be within 2 inches of the knee. No cargo shorts, gym shorts, skirts, nor denim material.

DRESS CODE POLICY

Jumper/Dress

- Type: Students in kindergarten through 2nd grade may wear a uniform jumper or a polo style dress with the A.D. Henderson University School logo offered by *Wizard Creations*.
- Color: Solid khaki or solid navy blue jumpers or navy blue dresses are acceptable colors.

Shoes & Socks

- Type: Students must wear closed toe and closed back shoes.
- Presentation: Laced shoes must be tied and shoes must match.
- Type prohibited: Shoes with wheels, clogs, sandals, flip-flops, and crocs are not acceptable. *If student must wear alternative footwear due to injuries, they must check in with school nurse for approval.*

Sweatshirts & Cardigans

- Sweatshirts and any other outerwear must be solid red, solid navy blue or solid white or any F.A.U. branded sweatshirt. No denim jackets.

DRESS CODE POLICY

6th – 8th Grade

Personal Appearance and Accessories

- Belts: Recommended for students in 6th – 8th grades, with pants, shorts, and skorts that have belt loops.
- Accessories: All accessories must be appropriate for school, not pose a threat to health / safety, and must not be distracting. This includes jewelry, socks, and other wearables.
 - Head attire, including kerchiefs, caps, hats, bandanas, scarves, and similar items are not permitted, except for religious reasons.
 - Hair presentation, including spray painting hair, dying hair to an unnatural hair color, and/or distracting style, is not permitted.
 - Sunglasses may not be worn indoors unless a doctor's note is on file with the school nurse.
- Backpacks: Backpacks are permitted at every grade level and must be neat and organized at all times.

Shirts

- Type: Students may wear knit polo shirts, athletic-style polo, or athletic style t-shirt with the A.D. Henderson University School logo offered by *Wizard Creations*.
- Color: Solid navy blue, solid white, or solid red are acceptable colors.
- Presentation: Shirts must be tucked in at all times. No clothing item may be faded, frayed, or have holes.

Bottoms

- Type: Students must wear traditional (chino-style flat front) uniform pants, shorts, or appropriate length skorts.
- Color: Solid khaki or solid navy blue are acceptable colors.
- Presentation: Pants must be appropriately sized and securely fastened at the waist. No clothing item may be faded, frayed or have holes.
- Type prohibited: Shorts and skorts must not be rolled down at the waist and/or rolled up at the hem line, and must be within 2 inches of the knee. No cargo shorts, gym shorts, skirts, nor denim material.

DRESS CODE POLICY

Shoes & Socks

- Type: Students must wear closed toe and closed back shoes.

DRESS CODE POLICY

9th – 12th Grade

Personal Appearance and Accessories

- Belts: Recommended with pants, shorts, and skorts that have belt loops.
- Accessories: All accessories must be appropriate for school, not pose a threat to health / safety, and must not be distracting. This includes jewelry, socks, and other wearables.
 - Head attire, including kerchiefs, caps, hats, bandanas, scarves, and similar items are not permitted, except for religious reasons.
 - Hair presentation, including spray painting hair, dying hair to an unnatural hair color, and/or distracting style, is not permitted.
 - Sunglasses may not be worn indoors unless a doctor's note is on file with the school nurse.
- Tattoos: Students are not permitted to display tattoos while in school dress.
- Backpacks: Backpacks are permitted at every grade level and must be neat and organized at all times.

Shirts

- Type: Students must wear an appropriate style shirt, such as a polo shirt, t-shirt, etc.
- Presentation: Shirts must be appropriately sized. No clothing item may be faded, frayed, or have holes.
- Type prohibited: No tube tops, backless shirts, bare midriffs, or tank tops with straps less than three fingers wide are permitted. Shirts may not advertise or promote gangs, sex, drugs, or alcohol, and/or contain indecent, offensive, or suggestive wording.

DRESS CODE POLICY

Bottoms

- Type: Students must wear an appropriate style bottom, such as, shorts, pants, or skorts.
- Presentation: Pants must be appropriately sized and securely fastened at the waist. No clothing item may be faded, frayed or have holes.
- Type prohibited: Shorts and skorts must not be rolled down at the waist and/or rolled up at the hem line, and must be within 2 inches of the knee.

Identification

- Owl Card badges must be worn at all times while on the A.D. Henderson University School & FAU High School campus.

DRESS CODE POLICY

Special Dress Code

Spirit Shirt Day (Every Friday K-8)

- Type: Any school-related shirt (i.e., Field Trip, Athletics, Earth Day, FAU, etc.) is permitted.
- Presentation: Shirts must be tucked in at all times into uniform style pants, shorts, and skorts. No clothing item may be faded, frayed, or have holes.
- Type Prohibited: Students are not permitted to wear non-school related shirts.

Casual Dress Day (As Offered By Administration K-8)

Shirts

- Type: Students must wear an appropriate style shirt, such as a polo shirt, t-shirt, etc.
- Presentation: Shirts must be appropriately sized. No clothing item may be faded, frayed, or have holes.
- Type prohibited: No tube tops, backless shirts, bare midriffs, or tank tops with straps less than three fingers wide are permitted. Shirts may not advertise or promote gangs, sex, drugs, or alcohol, and/or contain indecent, offensive, or suggestive wording.

Bottoms

- Type: Students must wear an appropriate style bottom, such as, shorts, pants, skorts.
- Presentation: Pants must be appropriately sized and securely fastened at the waist. No clothing item may be faded, frayed or have holes.
- Type prohibited: Shorts and skorts must not be rolled down at the waist and/or rolled up at the hem line, and must be within 2 inches of the knee.

Special Events (K-12)

- Appropriate dress attire will be determined by instructor and administration.
