To protect your privacy, Zoom has made the following additional security enhancements as of April 5, 2020:

Zoom enabled “Passwords” on all meetings to keep the meeting secure.

→ **Parents/Students:** The teacher will provide students with the password for each meeting.

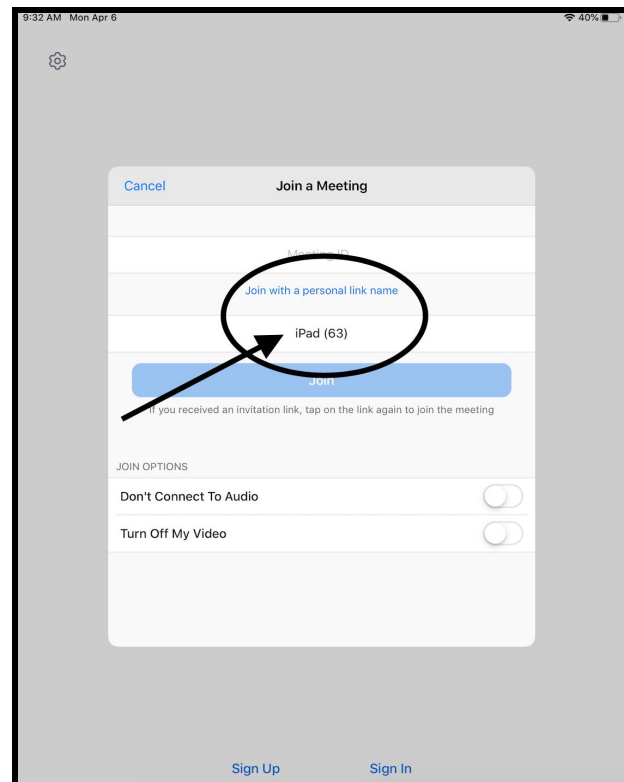
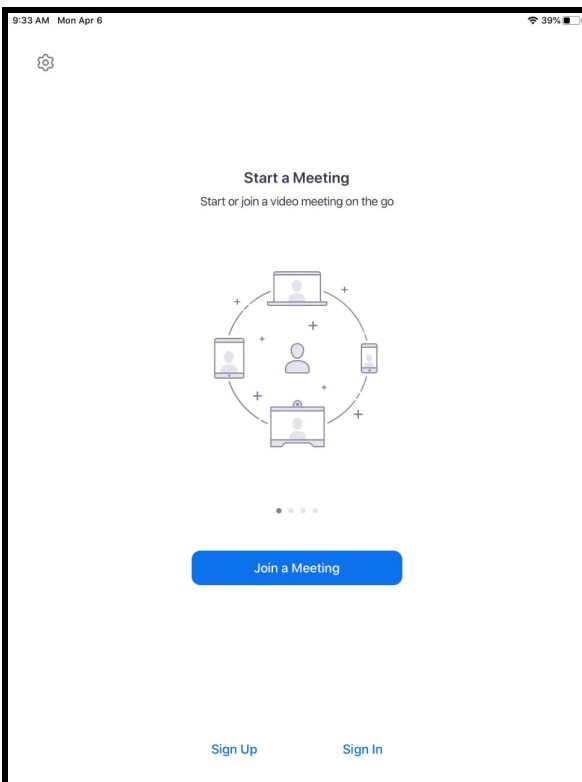
Zoom turned on “Waiting Rooms” so all participants must be admitted by the host of the meeting (teacher/staff member), only allowing the correct participants to join.

→ **Parents/Students:** Please make sure the “Zoom name” matches the student’s first and last name, especially if the device is shared. Only recognized student names will be admitted to the meetings. Below are some ways to ensure the student’s “Zoom name” matches your student’s first and last name.

How to Modify Your Zoom Name on Different Devices

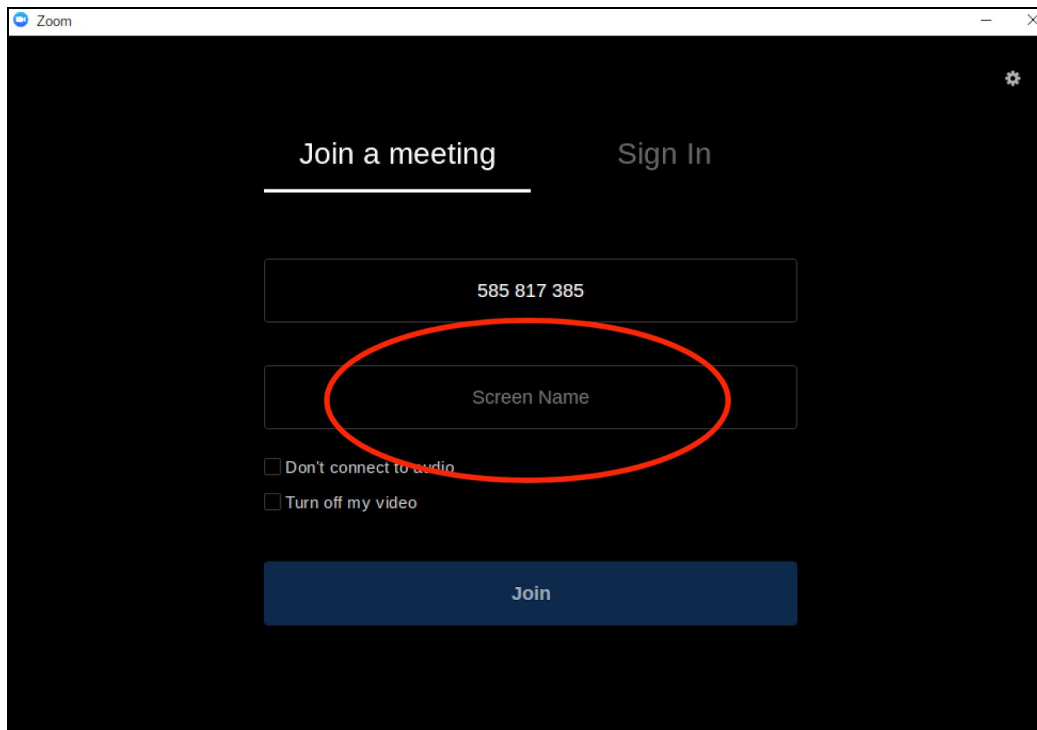
iPads

Using the Zoom app on any iPad, students click “Join a Meeting.” Before joining, students change their personal link name, aka “Zoom Name,” to their first and last name instead of ipad name. (*Type in the field where the arrow is pointing*).



Chromebooks

Using the Zoom app on a Chromebook, click "Join a Meeting." Before joining, students change the "Screen Name" by typing their first and last name.



Macbooks

Using the Zoom app on a Macbook, click on "Join." Before joining, students will type their first and last name.
