A. School Recognition Bonus 2025-2026

Ms. Gracie Diaz

Ms. Gracie Diaz provided a detailed summary of the 2025-2026 Florida School Recognition Program. The Florida School Recognition Program was created to recognize the efforts of outstanding faculty and staff from school districts and charter schools by providing financial awards to public schools. Florida Statute 1008.36, Florida School Recognition Program, recognizes and rewards schools with a sustained performance by receiving a school grade of "A," thus A.D. Henderson and FAU High School was awarded \$110,983. This represents a decrease of \$72,345 compared to the previous year. To maintain a similar bonus as last year, our district is supplementing the funds to match last year's allocation of \$183,328.
