Superintendent Update



- 88 students were inducted into the FAU High School Chapter of the National Honor Society.
- Our Middle School inducted 44 students into the National Junior Honor Society and Brady Abrams became a recipient of this year's NJHS Outstanding Achievement Award.
- Nicholas Ostheimer qualified and competed in the University of Kentucky Debate Tournament of Champions and placed 8th out of 130 debaters.
- The Cane Institute Students competed in the Florida State Science & Engineering Fair taking a number of awards. We will also have a student representing us in the International Science and Engineering Fair.
- Our Seaperch Underwater Robotics teams competed in the International SeaPerch Challenge at the University of Maryland, College Park. Our Middle School team placed 11th overall in the World.
- The Cane Institute ADHUS Drones in Schools teams competed in the Drones in Schools National Championship hosted at the AUVSI Xponential conference in Denver. Our teams won numerous awards which led to earn 1st overall, 2nd overall, 3rd overall, and 4th overall in the nation!
- The High School Boys Tennis Team won the District Championship, and the Girls Team finished in 2nd.
- The High School Track Team competed in the District Championship and 8 of our students won District Champions.
- Taylor-Nicole Overton is the 400 Middle School State Champion with a school record of 57.02.

- A. D. Henderson School/FAU High School has been recognized as one of the top-performing institutions in the country by the 2023 Niche State and National rankings.

- Summer school is a 5-week program aimed to support students in reading and math.
- Middle School 3-week Science Fair Research Camp: students will have the opportunity to explore science research topics or continue working on science fair research project.
