


TCI Presents at the National Science Teacher Association Conference

- Students used green screen technology to transport to Washington D.C. to present their findings. Students then built models of these places around the capital city and were incredibly proud of their creations and all they learned.








Middle School is Taking us by Storm!

- This motivated class has overcome the obstacles of COVID, and has made great achievements.
 The majority of our seniors will complete their bachelor's degrees at FAU within the next 18 months and others are headed to Ivy League and prestigious universities around the country.







FAU High School - Jupiter Campus, in Partnership with Max Planck Academy

- In April, the 1st Annual FAU High School Jupiter Campus, in partnership with Max Planck Academy Senior Research Symposium, was held to showcase research projects of the inaugural Class of 2022.
- The students worked in laboratories and field research sites to further scientific knowledge and our understanding of the world around us.
- 23 senior researchers published four peer-reviewed research papers, won over \$10,000 in grant funding and research awards to support their research endeavors and presented at university, state, and national conferences.

- This year's winners have shared innovative proposals to help overcome some of the greatest challenges facing the world today, from healthcare challenges to sustainability efforts and energy efficiency.










2022 ADHUS PTO Rainbow Run
